At last some good news!

The insurer has today finally given approval to pay for the repair work to the side walls. This will mean strengthening the brick work, and will probably include new gib linings to the walls. When complete, the hall will be usable again.

The process from here is that the loss adjuster will now get Hawkins to finalise the ambit of the work and select a contractor who will do the work. A building consent will likely be needed, as will sign-off by the builder and engineer.

We will need to have a site meeting shortly to sort how the logistics of the work.
